
Cotton yarn number 5 or 8
Crochet Hook 1.90 mm



Several crocheted flowers



Plastic bottle
Plastic sheet



Wooden stick
Transparent adhesive tape



Cardboard tube
(from tinfoil)



Fabric glue
Wire 0.8 mm




Floral tape
Insulating tape

Working 30 Rounds

PATTERN

MATERIALS

Cotton yarn
● Dark Pink
Crochet Hook 1.90 mm
Fabric glue
Plastic bottle
Plastic sheet
Cardboard tube (diameter 2,5 cm)
Transparent adhesive tape



BOUQUET

● Begin 5 CH and join with 1 ST.

Rnd 1- Work inside 3 CH, 15 DC. Join with 1 ST.

Rnd 2: 2 CH, 2 HDC increase in each stitch (30 HDC). Join with 1 ST.

Rnd 3: 30 SC in back loop.

Rnds 4-39: 30 SC x 40 rounds (1200 CH).

Rnd 40: 3 CH. *3 DC, 2 CH, skip 2 stitches*. Repeat **. Join with 1 ST.

Rnd 41: 3 CH. *1 DC, 2 DC increase, 1 DC, 3 CH. Skip the chains below*. Repeat **. Join with 1 ST.

Rnd 42: 3 CH. *4 DC, 5 CH. Skip the chains below*. Repeat **. Join with 1 ST.

Rnd 43: 3 CH. *4 DC, 3 CH, 1 DC in the chains below, 3 CH*. Repeat **. Join with 1 ST.

Rnd 44: 3 CH. *4 DC decrease, 3 CH, 3 DC increase in double stitch below, 3 CH*. Repeat **. Join with 1 ST.

Rnd 45: 3 CH. *1 DC, 3 CH, 3 DC increase in the next 3 double crochet, 3 CH*. Repeat **. Join with 1 ST.

Rnd 46: 3 CH. *3 DC increase, 3 CH, 9 DC in each stitch below, 3 CH*. Repeat **. Join with 1 ST.

Rnd 47: 3 CH. *1 DC, 2 DC increase, 1 DC, 3 CH.

In the next double crochet stitch, working: 2 DC decrease, 5 DC, 2 DC decrease, 3 CH*. Repeat **. Join with 1 ST.

Rnd 48: 3 CH. *3 DC increase, 3 CH, skip 2 stitches, 3 DC increase, 3 CH, 7 DC, 3 CH*. Repeat **. Join with 1 ST.

Rnd 49: 3 CH. *3 DC, 5 CH, skip the chains below, 3 DC, 3 CH.

In the next double crochet stitch, working: 2 DC decrease, 3 DC, 2 DC decrease, 3 CH*. Repeat **. Join with 1 ST.

Rnd 50: 3 CH. *3 DC, 1 CH, 9 DC into the chains below, 1 CH, 3 DC, 3 CH.

In the next double crochet stitch, working: 2 DC decrease, 1 DC, 2 DC decrease, 3 CH*. Repeat **. Join with 1 ST.

Rnd 51: 3 CH. *3 DC, 2 CH, skip the chains below. Working 1 SC, 2 CH, skip 1 stitc, 1 SC, 2 CH, skip 1 stitc, 1 SC, 2 CH, skip 1 stitch, 1 SC, 2 CH, skip the chains below, 3 DC, 3 CH, skip the chains below, 3 DC decrease*. Repeat **. Join with 1 ST.

Rnd 52: 3 CH. *3 DC, 3 CH, skip the chains below. Working 4 DC increase in the next four arches of chains below. Continue with 3 CH, skip the chains below. Working 1 SC*. Repeat **. Join with 1 ST.

Rnd 53: 3 CH. *3 DC decrease, 5 CH. Working 3 DC decrease (1 DC in the chains below, 2 DC in the next double crochet below). 5 CH, 3 DC decrease, 5 CH. Working 3 DC decrease (2 DC in the next double crochet below, 1 DC in the chains below). Continue with 5 CH, 3 DC decrease*. Repeat **. Join with 1 ST.

Rnd 54: *6 SC into the first arc of chains.
Working into the next five arches of chains: 3 SC, 1 PT, 3 SC.
6 SC into the last arch of chains*.
Repeat **. Join with 1 ST. Lock with 2 CH. Cut the thread.



Round 2.



Round 3:
working in back loop.



Round 39.



Round 44:
working 4 DC decrease.



Closed stitches.



Round 45: working 3 DC increase
in each stitch.



Round 47:
working 2 DC decrease.



Closed stitches.



Round 49.



Round 51:
working 3 DC decrease.



Closed stitches.



Round 52: working 4 DC increase
in the arches of chains.



Round 53.



1 DC in the chains below and 2 DC
in the stitch below (do not join).



Join all the stitches
(decrease).



3 DC decrease e 5 CH.



2 DC in the double stitch below
and 1 DC in the chains below.



Decrease.



Working 5 CH
and 3 DC decrease.



Continue with
3 DC decrease.



Working 3 SC, 1 PT, 3 SC
in each arc of chains.



Insert cardboard tube into the doily.



With a pen, mark the corresponding measurement at round 39.



Mark the tube along the circumference.



Cut the cardboard tube where marked.



Wrap the cardboard tube with transparent tape.



Cardboard tube wrapped in adhesive tape.



Cut out the top
of the plastic bottle.



Cover the table with plastic sheet.
Wet and squeeze the bouquet.



Impregnate with fabric glue.



Insert the tube into the doily.



Place the tube on the bottle.



Place and stretch the doily.
Let dry.




Bouquet dry.



Remove the plastic bottle.



Bouquet.



Cut a long piece of wire
and fold one end.



Insert wire (in the shape of a hook)
between stitches of Round 2.



Wire.



Insert wire up to the edge of bouquet.



Cut the excess wire and fold it.



Repeat 6 times.



Join a flower to wooden stick using insulating tape.



Cover with floral tape.



Using wire or wool thread, join the several flowers.



Join the flower stem
as you pleasure.



Using crochet hook, enlarge
the hole at the base of bouquet.



Try to insert the wooden stick
into the bouquet.



Fill with other flowers.



Join the other flowers.



Try several times.



Place flowers as you want.



Join the baby's breath twisting wire at base of flowers.



Baby's breath joined.



Insert flowers into the bouquet as proof.



Place the flowers as you pleasure.



Cover the stem of flowers with insulating tape.



Join some leaves
at stem of flowers.



Insert wire
between the stem of flowers.



Twisting wire.
Insert flowers into the bouquet.



Insert flowers into the bouquet.



Using crochet hook,
catch the wire.



Let out the wire.




Twist wire around the bouquet.



Twisting wire.



Hide the wire into the bouquet.



Slice the wooden stick at base.



Cut wooden stick.



Cover the wire around the bouquet with satin ribbon.



Bouquet completed.
