MATERIALS

Cotton yarn

○ White

● Soft Yellow

● Soft Pink

Crochet Hook 1.90 mm

Wire 0.6 mm



PETAL 1

○ Begin 18+1 CH.

1 Rnd: 3 SC, 3 DC, 6 TC, 3 DC, 6 SC, 3 DC, 6 TC, 3 DC, 3 SC.

2 Rnd: Work all around in SC incorporating wire 0.6 mm.

Lock with 2 CH. Cut the thread.

Shape the petal and twist the wire.

Make 3 petals.

PETAL 2

○ Begin 18+1 CH.

1 Rnd: 3 SC, 3 DC, 6 TC, 3 DC, 6 SC, 3 DC, 6 TC, 3 DC, 3 SC.

2 Rnd: Work incorporating wire 0.6 mm: 1 SC, 1 HDC, 1 DC.

2 TC increase, 1 TC. Repeat ** 5 times.

Continue with 1 DC, 1 HDC, 6 SC, 1 HDC, 1 DC.

1 TC, 2 TC increase. Repeat ** 5 times.


Continue with 1 DC, 1 HDC, 1 SC. Join with 1 ST.

Lock with 2 CH. Cut the thread.


Shape the petal and twist the wire.

Make 1 petal.

PETAL 1




PETAL 2

LABELLUM

Working in rows.

● Begin 19 CH.

1 Row: 1 CH, 5 SC, 4 HDC, 3 DC increase, 4 HDC, 5 SC.

2 Row: 1 CH, 5 SC, 5 HDC, 3 DC increase, 5 HDC, 5 SC.

3 Row: 1 CH, 5 SC, 6 HDC, 3 DC increase, 6 HDC, 5 SC.

4 Row: 1 CH, 5 SC, 7 HDC, 3 DC increase, 7 HDC, 5 SC.

5 Row: 1 CH, 5 SC, 8 HDC, 3 DC increase, 8 HDC, 5 SC.

6-8 Rows: 1 CH, 5 SC, 19 DC, 5 SC x 3 rows.

9 Row: 1 CH, 5 SC, 8 HDC, 3 DC decrease, 8 HDC, 5 SC.

10 Row: 1 CH, 5 SC, 7 HDC, 3 DC decrease, 7 HDC, 5 SC.

11 Row: 1 CH, 5 SC, 6 HDC, 3 DC decrease, 6 HDC, 5 SC.

12 Row: 1 CH, 5 SC, 5 HDC, 3 DC decrease, 5 HDC, 5 SC.

13 Row: 1 CH, 5 SC, 4 HDC, 3 DC decrease, 4 HDC, 5 SC.

14 Row: Fold the labellum in half. Join the edges working 8 SC.

15 Row: 1 CH, 8 ST. On the top of labellum, working 6 SC.

16 Row: Fold the labellum in half. Join the edges working 8 SC.

17 Row: 1 CH, 8 ST. On the top of labellum, working 4 CH, 6 TC decrease.

Join with 1 ST. Cut the thread. Turn over labellum.



○ 18 Row: Begin 3 CH and work 5 DC increase. Join with 1 ST in the first stitch.

Finish processing in rows.

19 Rnd: Begin 7+1 CH and work 7 SC. Continue with 1 SC in each double crochet below.

● 20 Rnd: 1 SC, 2 DC, 2 HDC, 4 SC, 2 HDC, 2 DC, 1 SC. Skip 2 stitches. Join with 1 ST.

Lock with 2 CH. Cut and hide the thread.





Row 13.



Fold labellum in half.



Row 14:
Join the edges working 8 SC.



Row 15:
working 8 ST.



On the top of labellum,
working 6 SC.



Join the edges of labellum
in the other side.



Row 17.



Working 6 TC decrease.



Join with 1 ST.



Row 18:
working 3 CH and 5 DC increase.



Join with 1 ST in the first stitch.
Begin 7+1 CH.



Round 19: continue with 1 SC
in each double crochet below.



Round 20.



Skip 2 stitches.
Join with 1 ST.



Labellum.



Insert wadding into the labellum.



Labellum filled.



Fold inward
the upper edge of labellum.



Labellum completed.



Insert wire between the stitches of Row 17.



Insert labellum at centre of flower.



Twist wire.



Flower completed.



OPTIONAL: apply fabric glue on the labellum.




Apply some seed beads.
Let dry.



Join the flower to the woodenstick
using the insulating tape.



Cover stem with green floral tape.



Stem covered.



Flower completed.

Oblong Leaf



MATERIALS

Acrylic Wool

● Light Green

Crochet Hook 3.50 mm


Wire 0.8 mm



LEAF

- Begin 30+1 CH.
- 1 Rnd: 1 SC, 1 DC, 18 TC, 5 DC, 10 SC, 5 DC, 18 TC, 1 DC, 1 HDC.
- 2 Rnd: 1 SC, 3 DC increase, 20 TC, 4 DC, 4 SC, 1 CH, 4 SC, 4 DC, 20 TC, 3 DC increase, 1 SC.
- 3 Rnd: Work incorporating wire 0.8 mm:
32 SC, 3 DC increase in the chain below, 32 SC.
Shape the petal and twist the wire.
- 4 Rnd: (optional) 5 SC. Work *1 SC, 2 CH*. Repeat ** 56 times.
Insert crochet hook in the sixth stitch. Join the edges of leaf in ST.
Lock with 2 CH. Cut the thread.

LEAF



To get a smaller or larger leaf,
remove or add the section indicated.



Work incorporating wire 0.8 mm.



Insert crochet hook in the sixth stitch.



Join the edges of leaf in ST.



Join the leaf to the woodenstick using the insulating tape.



Cover stem with green floral tape.

Assembly

MATERIALS

Vase
Oasis floral foam
Wooden sticks
Fabric glue
Pebbles



2 Orchids



3 Leaves
(different size)



In a bowl, add the pebbles
and fabric glue.



Mix.



Insert floral foam into the vase.



Apply the pebbles.



Dip the base of stem
in the fabric glue.



Insert stem into the vase.




Place orchids and leaves
into the vase as you pleasure.



Let dry.
